"Interface" is a 4 to 6 week college course set up in the Highlands of Papua New Guinea among the Bena Bena people designed to expose young men and women to tribal missions. Our role is to maintain the facility and grounds, as well as classroom teaching and personal interaction with the students. We will spend most of our time walking beside the students and encouraging them in their walks with the Lord.

The second part of our ministry is to the Bena Bena people. We are church planters and our desire is to see a mature church planted and growing among the Bena people. As to date there is 19 believers out of 60,000 Bena people.
