BE A DISCIPLE Week 1

Intro: In this campaign we are learning about the 4 chairs of Discipleship –

Chair 1 - Come and See (John 1:39)

Chair 2 - Follow Me (John 1:43)

Chair 3 - Become a Fisher of People (Matt 4:19)

Chair 4 - Go Make Disciples (Matt 28:19)

As Disciples of Jesus we are asking these 2 questions throughout this campaign:

What chair are you in?

What chair do you need to move towards?

Our lessons throughout the next eight weeks will focus on the Eight Attitudes we need to have in order to receive the blessings of God.

Attitude One: You Need God

Read: Matthew 5:3 "God blesses those who are poor and realize their need for him, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs.

The first Attitude we will look at is Spiritual Poverty or knowing we need God.

Questions:

- 1. What need in your life do you think about most?
- 2. How do you make sure that need is met?
- 3. Why is it so important to know you need God in order to experience the Kingdom of God?
- 4. When did you first realize you needed God and what was the need?
- 5. When do you tend to ask God for help?
- 6. What is it that you ask God for the most?
- 7. What is the greatest obstacle that keeps you from going to God, with your needs, on a regular basis?
- 8. Do you ever feel that you don't want to bother God with "that small issue"? Why is this wrong thinking?

As you pray together tonight, encourage everyone to share a need. As you pray, ask everyone to pray with their hands open with their palms up, as a physical way of showing our need for God's provision and help.

Weekly Challenge: As you pray this week, whenever possible, pray with your hands open palms up to God. Work to ask Him for what you need each and every day this week. Keep track of a need that God meets this week that you can share with the group next week.
