We so value our friendship with you over these many years and the way you have given and prayed for us so generously and faithfully!

Great news with Jerry's recent cancer checkup! His numbers remain very low – which indicates no cancer present. We are so thankful, relieved, and praising God for this good report. They will continue to check through bloodwork every 6 months.

An update on our next trip to Canada. This is the language where refugees from northern Africa have been working with the missionary team. Tentative dates have been set for April 21 – May 11th in Calgary. The community there has their own leadership, and they are working on finding people to work on the literacy team those 3 weeks to write the curriculum. Would you pray for the right people to be put on the team; those who can work together well and have creativity to write all the reading practice stories that we will need to teach the letters. Also, there is some disunity among the community leadership team itself. Not that anyone is against the literacy workshop. But power-struggles within the team that are keeping them from working together to make the decisions. We know there is an enemy who doesn't want the people to have God's Word in their language and be able to read it. So, would you pray that God would work in these situations?
